## Bubbles

### De Bortoli DB Classique

**Bottle 3,000**

Appealing fresh fruit and citrus aromas. Lively fresh flavours with just a touch of residual sweet fruit. A fine persistent bead, the finish on the palate is crisp and clean. NSW Australia.

### Moët & Chandon Imperial

**Bottle 12,000**

Golden straw yellow with green highlights. The vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit. The delicious sumptuousness of white-fleshed fruits (pear, peach, apple). Champagne France.

## White

### Willowbank, Semillon/Chardonnay

**Glass 700 Bottle 3,000**

Lifted quince and citrus with tropical stone-fruit characters, complimented by subtle herbaceous characters and a whisper of toasty oak. A very focused wine, showing great depth of flavour. An impeccably balanced palate finishes long with crunchy acid and tasty oak. NSW Australia.

### Matetic Corralillo, Sauvignon Blanc

**Glass 800 Bottle 3,200**

Pale bright yellow with green hues. The nose offers herbal and citric aromas such as grapefruit alongside tropical fruits such as mango and papaya. In the mouth it offers a fresh and juicy acidity, great volume with an elegant and balanced long finish. San Antonio Valley, Chile.

### Geoff Merrill Pimpala Road, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon

**Bottle 4,000**

This classic white wine brings together the strengths of two varieties with delicate grassy tropical notes of Sauvignon Blanc complemented by the lime and blossom characters of Semillon. South Australia.

### Invivo Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc

**Bottle 5,300**

Tropical aromas, fresh sliced bell peppers and floral lime zest rise from the glass initially. This is well backed up by a vibrant, cutting fresh palate with deceptive power and concentration. Evidence of the lees contact adds a textural dimension to the focused palate and bouncing tropical fruit. This wine will develop in the bottle over time and its complexity will become more marked between sweet fruit spectrum and almost savory herbal notes. Marlborough, NZ.

### Lecher Festwein, Grüner Veltliner

**Bottle 5,600**

Fruity spicy fragrance with apple and pear, hint of pepper. Mature fruit on the palate, elegant refined finish. Friendship wine with Lech (Austria), Kampen (Germany), Beaver Creek (USA) and Happo-One. Kleinriedenthal Austria

### Geoff Merrill, Reserve Chardonnay

**Bottle 6,800**

The aroma is a wonderful blend of citrus and fruit salad, subtle oak and the beginnings of complex secondary aromas that comes with bottle age. It shows some straw with subtle toast and cashew nuts. The mid palate has filled out while still retaining fresh acidity and excellent structure. The wine is just at the very beginning of its optimum for drinking. Its youthful freshness is still very strong but the complexities of age are just starting to display their potential. South Australia.

### Woodlands, Chardonnay

**Bottle 7,400**

This wine has a beautiful combination of being both uplifting and refreshing on the palate, but also powerful and textural. A very muscular and powerful wine, the nose displays an array of orchard fruits (apricot, peach, nectarine) combined with toasty French oak notes. The palate follows the lead, mirroring the flavours of the nose and finishing with lingering fruit and natural acidity. Margaret River, Western Australia.

### Cullen "Kevin John", Chardonnay

**Bottle 18,000**

The highest recommendation. Intense and complex, combining attractive citrus, almond, pear and green apple aromas against a background of subtle vanillin oak. Rich crisp bright and focused, with the fresh citrus, honeysuckle and almond flavours complimented by the good acidity. A wine of great purity precision, length and persistence. Margaret River, Western Australia.

## Red

### **Willowbank, Shiraz/Cabernet**

**Glass 700 Bottle 3,000**

Crimson red with hints of purple. Fragrant dark fruit aromas with hints of red cherry and spicy oak. A fruit driven palate, with blackberry and cherry flavours, well integrated with hints of oak. NSW Australia.

### **Koyle Gran Reserva, Cabernet Sauvignon**

**Glass 800 Bottle 3,200**

Deeply colored, with plenty of black fruit character, showing a great presence of currant and blueberry, with hints of exotic spice and cedar. This Cabernet is a full expression of origin, showing a real grip of acidity and mineral notes. Ripe tannins are solid and velvety, and come together beautifully, with a silky and balanced finish. D.O. Colchagua Valley, Chile.

### **Heart & Soil Smooth Red, Cabernet Sauvignon, Dolcetto, Lagrein, Shiraz**

**Bottle 3,800**

Supple leather notes. Blueberry, strawberry jam and raisins with cinnamon, vanilla and nutmeg flavours. Rounded tannins and a complex finish. Langhorne Creek, Australia.

### **Glaetzer Wallace, Shiraz Grenache**

**Bottle 4,800**

Glaetzer Wallace takes on the traditional Barossa Valley blend of shiraz and grenache in a thoroughly modern way. Rich, peppery old-vine shiraz dominates and adds weight, texture and fleshy richness to the palate. Grenache provides complex tannins and fresh acidity to the mix, with luscious red cherry and hints of aromatic spices and anise. By Ben Glaetzer. SA Australia.

### **Lecher Festwein, Rotweincuvee**

**Bottle 5,500**

Lively fragrance of dark berries, black cherries, spices and delicate toasted aromas. Balanced, powerful and full-bodied on the palate. A wine with finesse and a long finish. Friendship wine with Lech (Austria), Kampen (Germany), Beaver Creek (USA) and Happo-One. Grossnondorf, Austria

### **Mitolo Jester, Cabernet Sauvignon**

**Bottle 6,700**

Bright, lush and juicy, Jester Cabernet Sauvignon shows a full bodied palate and mouth filling richness. 20% of the fruit has been handled in the Amarone manner- this technique of drying fruit adds complexity and fullness and produces soft juicy tannins. Jester Cabernet is upfront and approachable for early appreciation, delivering excellent quality for the price. South Australia

### **Cullen "Diana Madeline" (Bordeaux Blend)**

**Bottle 18,500**

The highest recommendation. Amazing clarity and complexity, with a very attractive combination of cassis, chocolate, aniseed and ironstone aromas. Plush silky and long. The palate represents a marvellous compote of fresh red fruits, made up of cassis, plum and cherry flavours and which are complemented by very fine and elegant tannins. The wine has a wonderfully long and persistent finish. Margaret River, Western Australia.

### **Chateau Palmer 2007, Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon/Petit Verdot**

**Bottle 90,000**

Nose with hints of vanilla, raspberry, redcurrant, and bay leaf, with understated oak. Beautiful balance between alcohol and tannin on the palate. Concentrated with rich tannin and attractive freshness. Bordeaux Medoc AOC Margaux, France.
